Appendix XV: 1930 Constitution

CONSTITUTION
THE HERSHEY INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

NAME

The name shall be The Hershey Industrial School Alumni Association.

PURPOSE

This association is organized for the purpose of looking after the general welfare of those who were formerly students at The Hershey Industrial School and left there with a good record.

MEMBERSHIP

The membership shall consist of those who were formerly students at The Hershey Industrial School, left there with a commendable record and have been elected to membership by a majority of the members present at any meeting.

OFFICERS
DUTIES OF OFFICERS

The officers shall consist of: President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer, all of which will be elected at the Annual Meeting.

It shall be the duty of the **PRESIDENT** to be present at, and preside over, each meeting. He shall perform such other duties as are incumbent upon this officer in like associations.

The **VICE-PRESIDENT** shall be present at each meeting and take the duties of the President if that officer is not present or cannot perform his duties.

The **SECRETARY**. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep a list of the membership, to correspond with former students of the School, to endeavor to keep a close relationship between the Association and these former students, and to encourage members of the Association to assist each other in every reasonable means.

The **TREASURER**. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to collect all dues and other moneys that may come to the Association, to deposit these accounts under the name of the Association in The Hershey National Bank. It shall be his duty to make out checks in payment of bills against the Association after those bills have been approved by a Finance Committee which shall be appointed by the President.

APPENDIX XV: 1930 CONSTITUTION

This Finance Committee shall consist of three members, any two of whom may authorize the payment of a bill by their signature thereto.

COMMITTEES

STANDING COMMITTEE. The following shall constitute Standing Committees of this Association, and the members thereof shall be appointed by the President with the approval of a majority of the other officers: Finance Committee, Social Committee, Welfare Committee.

FINANCE COMMITTEE. It shall be the duty of the Finance Committee to investigate all bills prior to their payment and if they find them correct they shall approve the bills by writing the word “Approved” and their “Names” on the bill.

SOCIAL COMMITTEE. The Social Committee shall arrange for programs and social functions for the meetings.

WELFARE COMMITTEE. It shall be the duty of the Welfare Committee to assist the Secretary in looking after the general welfare of the members of the Association.

MEETINGS

First: There shall be at least one Annual Meeting of this Association and as many other meetings as may be called by the President or five other members of the Association. Second: Each member is permitted to bring his friends or relatives to any of the meetings provided he notifies the Secretary at least one week prior to the meeting concerning the number of the guests he will bring with him. The Annual Meeting will be held on the day of graduation from High School.

A QUORUM

At least six members shall be present at any meeting in order to transact business.

DUES

Since it is the purpose of this Association to keep in touch with former students, to assist in procuring employment for such students, and to provide such other assistance as may from time to time be necessary there shall be annual dues of \$1.00. These dues may, however, be changed at any annual meeting on a majority vote of those present.

ADDITIONS AND AMENDMENTS

Additions and Amendments of these by-laws may be proposed at any meeting, and they shall be presented, read, and tabled until the succeeding Annual Meeting at which time they shall be voted on for adoption or rejection.
