

## THE AGREEMENT

**Note:** The following is to be completed at the office upon the day the applicant is admitted to the School. If the parent or sponsor is unable to accompany the boy on the day of admission, the following agreement should be completed and signed by the parent or sponsor when filing the application. (Signature of witness necessary.)

the "Boy") I wish to apply on his behalf for his enrollment as a student at Milton Hershey School (which  
is referred to in this application as the "School").

If this application is accepted by you it is understood and agreed that during the term of  
his enrollment at the School (which is referred to in this application as the "Enrollment Term") the terms  
and conditions of his enrollment will be as follows:

Enroll-

Term

1. The Enrollment Term will commence with the date of your acceptance of this  
application or the date on which the boy arrives to attend the School, whichever date shall  
later occur, and, except as hereinafter otherwise provided, shall extend to the date on which  
the Boy arrives at the age of 18 years. ( \_\_\_\_\_, 19 \_\_\_\_ )

Right of

withdraw

2. Upon written notice to you I may withdraw the Boy from the School at any time  
prior to the date above mentioned if in my own judgment such withdrawal is for the welfare of  
the Boy. In such case the Enrollment Term will automatically terminate with such withdrawal.  
Although such right of withdrawal is reserved, I nevertheless represent to you that in making  
this application it is not my intention that the Boy's enrollment will be temporary. The right of  
withdrawal set forth in this application shall extend also to any competent authority, such as a  
personal guardian, who lawfully succeeds me in my control over the Boy during his minority.

Right of  
Managers  
to Dismiss  
Boy

3. The Enrollment Term may also be terminated by you or your successors as  
managers of the School (herein called the "Managers") prior to the date mentioned in  
paragraph 1 for any of the reasons or under any of the circumstances set forth as grounds for  
removal of the Boy in Section 20 of the Deed of Trust of the late Milton S. Hershey under  
which the School was founded.\*

\* Excerpt from Section 20: "If, in the opinion of the Managers, any orphan admitted to the School should become incompetent to learn, or to master a trade, or from physical ailments it would be inexpedient for him to continue his studies and training, or become insubordinate, or be guilty of vice or crime, or become an unfit companion for the others, or has so conducted himself as not worthy of future and continued support and education, or is so competent to work at his chosen trade, that he is qualified to be self-supporting, he may be removed or expelled from the School by the Managers...."

Instruction

4. During the Enrollment Term the Managers will cause the Boy to be instructed and provided with board and maintenance, all as set forth in the Deed of Trust above referred to, and without cost to the Boy or the undersigned.

Boy to

5. During the Enrollment Term the Boy shall faithfully and honestly obey the Managers, or the School staff selected by them, and conform to their regulations and directions with reference to his behavior, residence, visiting privileges, vacations, studies, chores, duties and other matters relating to the conduct and training of the Boy and he shall be subject to any reasonable disciplinary measures deemed advisable by the Managers or the School staff.

Operations  
and  
Medical  
Treatment

6. I agree that whenever during the Enrollment Term a doctor employed or selected by the School shall deem it necessary for the health or welfare of the Boy that a surgical operation be performed on, or medical treatment be administered to the Boy, I will assume all responsibility connected with, and hereby consent to, such operation or treatment and will in no wise hold the School, the Managers, the staff or such doctor responsible therefor. The cost of any such operation or treatment shall, however, be borne by the School.

Baptism

7. I will assume all responsibility with reference to the baptism of the Boy or the observance of other special religious rites.

Residence  
of the Boy

8. During the Enrollment Term the Boy's residence will be at Hershey, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.

Further  
Education  
of the Boy

9. I am informed that the Deed of Trust above referred to provides that the Managers may, in their discretion, before or after the arrival of the Boy at the age of 18 years, provide for the further education of the Boy at some other school, college or university. If, in the discretion of the Managers, this is done, the Enrollment Terms will be appropriately extended (subject, however, at all times to the rights of removal referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3).

End of  
Enrollmen  
t Term

10. At the end of the Enrollment Term, whether occurring by lapse of time or otherwise, any further financial responsibility for the Boy on the part of the School or the Managers shall automatically cease.
